## Dear Parents and Students,

This is an exciting time for all of us at the Oregon Conservatory of Performing Arts (OCPA). This is our sixth year offering unique after-school and Saturday classes in the performing arts to students ages 6 to 17. Our classes this fall include such old favorites as *Performance Dance* and *Kids on Stage* as well as new offerings in improvisation and musical theatre. Our classes for teens include *Creative Acting* and *Capture the Applause*. Younger kids can explore their imaginations in *Playtime Acting* and *Once Upon a Time*. Other new offerings are *From Your Word to the Stage*, which centers on improvisational writing and acting for the stage; *Where to Begin in Musical Theatre*; and *Singing, Movement, and Magic*.

We've also added instruction in musical instruments in *Rock Band 101: School of Rock*. Kids who want to perform in a rock band learn to sing with mics and try their hands at electric guitar, drums, sax, keyboard, and more. The session ends with a live rock show and includes a digitally recorded CD of the performance.

We're particularly excited about *Grown': The Project*—a class for students 12 to 17, who will update an original coming-of-age script with their own words and experiences. They will learn scriptwriting and discover the process of theatre—from taking the words off the page, to rehearsal, to the technical design aspects, to the culminating performances on stage in area schools. This is the only class for which students must audition.

All classes will perform at an end-of-session recital. The last day to register is September 7, but please don't wait—classes fill up quickly and class size is limited. If you have questions or for further information, please call the Conservatory office at (541) 776-9118.
