
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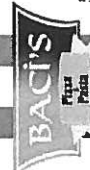
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Director's Notes



Each summer students sign up for our camps and we as directors never really know what we will get. Usually, the ability and maturity levels vary and we have a mix of kids. At one point during the first week of this camp, Mrs. Katzmar and I looked at each other and agreed that the students in this camp were overall young, both in age and in theatre experience.

This fact made the final week of camp that much sweeter. In each OCPA camp, there are normally one or two "ringers" who steal the show and lead the other campers to victory. In "Sleeping Beauty Kids" the role of leadership was held by many. This is not to say that we don't have a few older returning campers who have taken on and done a fabulous job with some of the larger roles, but I am so proud of these youngsters who learned their parts and perform with energy.

Trying to put together a fully-staged musical with mostly 7, 8 and 9 year olds can present problems. When putting together the staging and choreography for this show, I thought I had to simplify the steps to best fit the students' ability levels. As you will see, I didn't simplify anything.

I am so proud of these youngsters who worked INCREDIBLY HARD to reach the bar that I had raised so high. Socially, this cast got along great and played well together. In rehearsal, students were respectful and took criticism in a way that was well beyond their years.

I want to say BRAVO to the cast of "Sleeping Beauty Kids." Break a leg and have a wonderful time doing what you do so well.

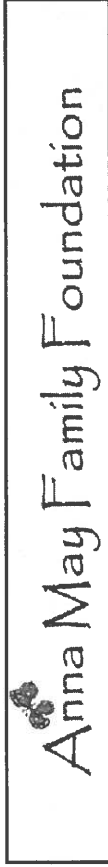

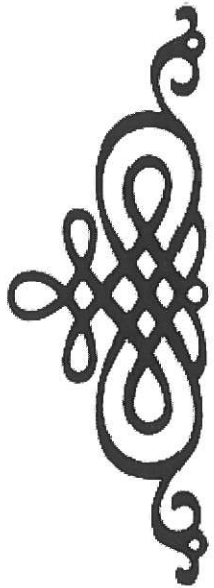

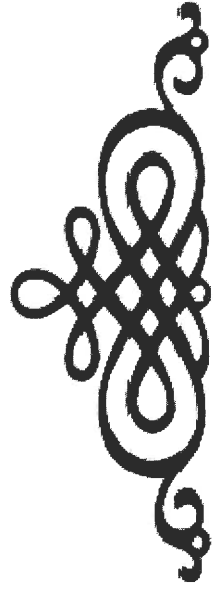
